Students of Color:

- Diversity, Equity, & Community Committee to promote diversity, advocate for equity, & foster inclusivity in the CHS & our larger communities.
 - AESHM Social Justice Committee
 - Partnering with Multicultural Student Affairs to provide one free tutor group per semester for academic courses
 - Implementation of the Connect Four Learning Community which provides a supportive sense of community for students of color, and tools to encourage academic success, leadership, and networking within the university community.
 - Grow through Relationships & Conversations with Others (GRO), a dialogue group for intercultural students to meet new people & discuss current events and other interesting topics.
 - A \$570,000 project provided by the National Science Foundation aiming to raise the number of Black men in engineering.
 - Planning of meetings & open forums to openly discuss social justice & injustice for students to educate themselves more & learn to advocate for underrepresented populations.
 - Many faculty members have also developed workshops with the intention of helping graduate students & faculty of color prevail over systemic barriers in our society, & other professors are consistently creating new technologies & ideas to enrich our education system by reducing inequity, promoting research, and extending opportunities to non-native English speakers.
