EXECUTIVE ORDER 2025-1-004

Establishing the Presidential Task Force on Affordability

By the authority invested in me as President of the Student Body by the Student Government Constitution and Bylaws, I hereby order the following:

The Presidential Task Force on Affordability is hereby established for the 2025-2026 term, as of May 7th, 2025.

The Affordability Task Force will be responsible for determining and taking steps to reduce the financial hardship faced by Iowa State students. Their task is to develop an executable plan along with steps that Student Government can take toward reducing the cost of attending Iowa State University. The Presidential Task Force on Affordability shall work closely in collaboration with campus departments, university administration, and students, to have an inclusive and coordinated effort around economic sustainability.

The Presidential Affordability Task Force will submit a comprehensive Affordability Report to President Brandt at the end of every session, containing primary findings, progress, and recommendations for future action Student Government can take. Along with the Affordability Report, the task force shall submit a cent-by-cent breakdown to President Brandt and Vice President Vlasek including all spending of the Student Activity Fee for the previous Fiscal Year.

The Task Force shall be comprised of the following members:

- A) The Director of Affordability, who shall serve as Chair and vote only in the event of a tie
- B) The Director of Operations, who shall serve as the Vice Chair
- C) The Finance Director, or their designee, who shall serve as an ex-officio member
- D) At-large members as appointed by President Brandt

The President and Vice President may serve as ex-officio members of the task force. Relevant Cabinet members who are not task force members may serve as consultants, at the discretion of the Chair.
